ABOUT OUR PROGRAM

The Adopt-A-Park/Trail Program (APAT) provides opportunities for individuals and organizations to get involved in a variety of capacities.

Program participation requires a one-year commitment from an individual or a group to meet a minimum of every other month (6 times per year) to clean-up a park or trail.
